

There will be a change in the rules for bags and backpacks this upcoming year. Students may utilize traditional bags and backpacks to transport personal items to and from school, but they must be stored in their locker during the school day. Students can use clear plastic or see through mesh bags or backpacks to take books and personal items to classes during the day. Students may also carry a small pencil case to classes. At the end of the day, students will be allowed to load their regular backpacks to take items home. There are many different versions of clear or mesh backpacks available on-line and the School Store will carry the clear plastic backpacks. Students are not required to purchase a bag unless they want to use it to carry items from class to class. When school starts on September 4th, we will discuss this with students and answer any questions they may have. This is consistent with other secondary schools in the La Crosse School District. Also, we will be adding a Resource Time during the Extended Learning Days. This means that there will be a Resource Time each day. This will be between 1st and 3rd hours on Wednesdays and 2nd and 4th hours on Thursday.
