

Central High School Can Collection

Each group will have a two-week period in which they can collect cans. The trailer for the can collection is in the High School parking lot. You will need a truck or large car with a # 2 bar hitch to pull trailer. Keys for unlocking the cages are hooked by the black box on the front of the trailer. Below you will find the list of locations and suggestions/ideas for collecting.

You will want to have 4 people, more would be better. It is suggested that you wear old clothes, since this can be a messy job and bring gloves, like garden or leather.

Have two people help unlock cage and hand up bags to the trailer. Have helpers stand on the wheel wells and empty bags into trailer. Make sure that **only cans**, no bottles, plastic or paper are dumped into the trailer. Once the bags are emptied put them into the plasti garbage can on the trailer or use a dumpster nearby. Once all 6 locations have been emptied, the trailer needs to be taken to Altra Metal Recycling at 2410 Hauser Street, located in the La Crosse Industrial Park by Kwik Trip, see hours below.

Trailer needs to be weighed first, then emptied and reweighed. Tell them the cans are for the **Central Booster Club** & note on the check stub what club/team collected the cans. The check will need to be given to either Jan Crandall or Sandy Cleary or it can be left in the Booster Club mailbox, near the 2nd floor High School office. The check will then be deposited into the Booster Club account and a check issued to the club for their amount, which is 80% of the total.

Locations:

- Hardees on State Road, across from Festival Foods.
- Kwik Trip on Losey Blvd, next to the alley.
- City Brewery, parking lot on Jackson and 3rd Streets
- GoodWill on Mormon Coulee Road
- Across from Walmart South on Mormon Coulee Road next to the laundry mat
- Hungry Peddler, cans are next to the shed in the back. NO CAGE
