Prior to these days, students should check to find their locker number and combination. This can be found by going into their Skyward account and clicking on the Student Info tab on the left side of the screen. Students should also know their lunch keypad number. That can be found under the Food Service tab using a parent's login of Skyward Family Access. Along with this, students should print or write down their class schedule along with the classroom number for each class.

Students that ride a bus to school this day, should report to their first hour class. If the room is not open, students should go to the Commons and sit at a desk.

Students that will find their own way to school are encouraged to not arrive until 7:30 a.m. if possible. Upon arrival, students can go to their first hour class or sit at a desk in the commons.

All students must complete the Qualtrics Survey either before school or at the beginning of 1st hour. This will come on an e-mail before school or students can access this by scanning a QR Code using their phone. The QR Code sheets will be placed around the school and in the 1st hour class. Students will receive a green check mark after they complete the survey and they must show that to their 1st hour teacher.

At 7:35 a.m., the first bell will ring, and this signifies that class begins in 5 minutes. If students are not in their classroom at this time, they should move to their first hour class.

At 7:40 a.m., the final bell will ring, and class begins. All students should be in the classroom by this time.

All students will eat Lunch at the same time. Students can eat school lunch, bring their own, or can leave campus to eat. If students do leave campus, they need to be back for the beginning of 6th hour which begins at 12:25.

At 2:50, classes will end. At this time, teachers will be available in their rooms for help or to answer questions until 3:25. Club advisors will be available to discuss what their clubs do and when they meet. Students that are riding the bus home, should either be in a classroom with a teacher or advisor, or waiting in the Commons until busses arrive at 3:20. Students that are finding their own way home, should either be in a classroom with a teacher or advisor, waiting in the Commons for their ride, or leave the building.

Covid-19 protocols that are being followed:

All students must wear a mask at all times. The mask must cover the nose and mouth.

All students must do their best to maintain social distance.

Students should walk on the right side of the hall and steps.

Students should not stop to talk during passing times.

Classrooms will have desks 6 feet apart and should not be moved.

Desks in the Commons will be 6 feet apart and should not be moved.

Students are encouraged to frequently use the hand sanitizers that are placed around the building.
