CM/NS Principal hiring

CMAP staffing

- Still have a staffing issue at CMAP when Laura Carlson left late last year then numbers did not go up so could not justify a hire
- We have hired a temporary TA (Mel Hanson) to help out Nine.
- There are 27 kids, 3 grades Melissa did not feel comfortable with just one person in the room but now we always have two staff members in the room
- In the process of hiring a new orchestra director for CMAP/Lincoln this will affect CMAP strings students
- Hired a new Art Teacher (hired Hannah Safner (sp)) this will likely affect Montessori art
- If we make a move to hire a Laura Carlson replacement Melissa will reach out to us
- Melissa is going to push for keeping the TA next year to help out Nine if numbers do not go up

Enrollment updates

- Our numbers were very much affected by the COVID
- At this point we have 21 23 students at the CMAP level, we usually have 30 42 kids so these numbers are way down
- Enrollment is down in general across the district but hard to put our low numbers into context
- It would be nice to put the declining enrollment into some more context the district has declined by ≈ 1400 students overall in the last few year CM/NS lost ≈ 100 students this year and 20 of them were from CM

Virtual open house

- Virtual open house for charter schools combined lots of different charter schools into one big event so parents can compare them on the spot CRVA, CM, CMAP, SOTA
- Nell will represent CM
- Mariah will be there for CM
- CMAP parent needed Barb Silbaugh will represent
- Nine will be there to represent CMAP

Food Truck Fundraiser - Monkey Business

- May 17th, picnic from 2 6pm, gives parents enough time to grab something before and to come back after pick-up
- Will drop the prices to make it more affordable
