Fundraising	Guest Shelley Shirel Spence was challenged in finding a way of fundraising that brought more money into the school Determined must-have expenses and tiered items Set aside the must-have funds for a year to ensure they could cover expenses if new process didn't work First year, did a walk-a-thon (Spence calls Fun Run), wasn't challenging, but some found it to be confusing – needed to get the first year under their belt – year 1 raised around \$5,000 Teachers were supportive, was not a lot work on their behalf, other than the event day Logistics to considerwhere to walk? music? First year was paper/pencil year, not online Kicked off with all school assembly, directions to parents on how to gather the funds, when to turn in, incentives Get Moving was life changing with the online access – increased fundraising significantly Templates, coaching, social media sharing, prizes Has become 'fabric of culture', setting goals (i.e. teachers sleeping on the roof, teachers painting nails) – were not solicited by PTO 90-95% profit With increased fundraising, kids were able to vote for things (ga-ga ball pit, basketball hoops, etc.) Suggest bringing Britney (AA) as she supported Get Moving for a while
