Communication Skills in Health 8



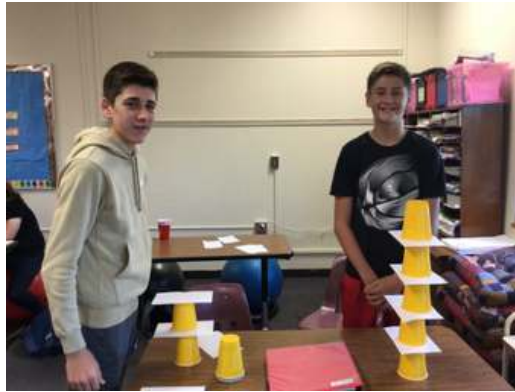
