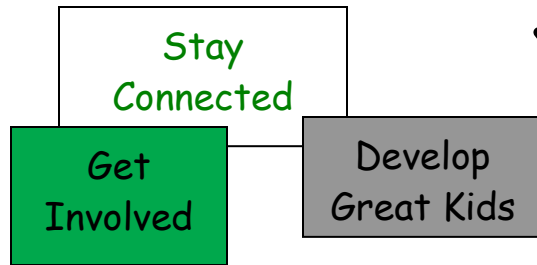


# Longfellow PTO
