Food Distribution

What: School Breakfasts & Lunches for all students-just drive up in the parking lot.

Where: Northside Elementary

When: Daily from 11:00-11:30 for no cost -through summer

What: Drive-up Fresh Produce (vegetables, fruit, and dairy)

Where: Logan High School parking lot by stadium

Northside community families are encouraged to drive to this location to receive a free bag of fresh produce and dairy products (based on availability).

Hunger Task Force JUNE

Currently, \$3 Billion has been offered from USDA to purchase fresh produce, meat, and dairy products. As part of the Hunger Relief Federation of Wisconsin, **The Hunger Task Force** is receiving supplemental food items from the Dairy Recovery Program and the CFAP (Coronavirus Food Assistance Program) The **products will be boxed and distributed** through Federation partners like us throughout the state to help Wisconsin families.

In keeping with the La Crosse County recommendations for social distancing, **The Hunger Task Force will hold a public drive-through distribution of these boxes at their warehouse at 1240 Clinton St. from 4-6pm (or until gone) every Friday through the end of June.**

Front Door Ministry:

Rental assistance, eviction prevention, gas cards: Deacon Tom Skemp of Cathedral of St. Joseph the Workman will be offering services at The Salvation Army of La Crosse County's Emergency Shelter until the contact and gathering restrictions put in place to slow the spread of the COVID-19 virus have abated. Primary assistance is available for housing, on a case-by-case basis. If your need is for housing or rental assistance you are advised to call first. Documentation regarding rent amounts and landlord contact information is required. Limited assistance may also be available on a case-by-case basis for transportation needs. A valid driver's license and proof of employment, either hard copy or on your phone, such as a current

week work schedule or very recent pay stub, are required to request a gas voucher. Similar requirements are required to request a voucher for doctor or hospital appointments. Requests for other types of assistance can be made and will be handled on a case-by-case basis. Applications can be made in person at the Salvation Army's intake office, just inside the shelter entrance weekday mornings 9:00 to 10:30, or over the phone at (715) 891-8819 weekday mornings 9:00 to 10:30.

FOOD SHARE - SNAP

Families who currently have Foodshare benefits have already automatically been brought up to the maximum amount (April 12 and April 26). Details are here:

If a family has not received Foodshare, but has qualified for free or reduced lunch, they will be eligible for Pandemic EBT benefits. Go to www.access.wi.gov to apply. Families will start to receive benefits based on the free/reduced numbers provided by school districts. If a family does not receive the benefits automatically, then they can begin to apply early May.
