Flu vaccine for children (6 months thru 18 years old) provided **at no cost** to the family.

Flu vaccine available for adults 19 years+:

- \$33.00 Fluzone Quadrivalent Injection
- \$60.00 Fluzone High Dose Injection (formulated for ages 65+ years)
- Payment:
  - Cash or check – if paying out of pocket
  - Medicare or Medicare Advantage Plans
  - Medicaid (MA) - except Mayo Health Traditions HMO
  - Quartz (Previously Gundersen Insurance) or Senior Preferred
  - WEA Insurance
  - WCA Insurance
  - Insurance card must be presented for plans listed above.
