Treasurer's Report: Digicopy check was written for $\$ 21.60$. Teacher requests amounted to $\$ 1,970.02$ from the Teacher Giving Tree. We have allocated $\$ 379.50$ for PBIS allocation. $\$ 16,536.86$ is our total balance with $\$ 16,157.36$ as our available balance. The swing set account has $\$ 14,899.94$. We still need to pay for the Pour in Place Foundation which is approximately 7 k as well as the path. Any extra money left in the swings account will be used to upgrade the playground.

Principal's Report: Great turnout and even better feedback from staff and families about the return of the Sweetheart's Dance. Thank you for this and your support!
Ava Hammes served her day as Principal. She was able to provide feedback to our superintendent, visit classrooms to observe student learning and teaching, as well as get to know students in other grades through lunch and recess supervision. School Breakfast Week was a major success! I was not able to get numbers from Heather (thought about that too late in the day) but they had to be fantastic. Many warm breakfast options were served and this got me excited about the potential of more hot breakfast options to come next year! We are gearing up for a busy week with conferences, field trips, and the school-wide concert. In April we have two family engagement events in the works: Movie Night is April 27th and a Future Kindergarten Night for incoming Kindergarteners on April 20th.

## Current Business:

Spring Conferences: PTO is providing lunch for conferences. Tomorrow is sub sandwiches, cookies. Thursday is Taco Bar

Spring Picnic: Stacey talked with Kenny Ahearn. We are not sure if he is available. Menu for picnic will be Hot Dogs $\$ 2.25$ and burger $\$ 2.55$ meal. Cost will approximately be $\$ 1600$. It will be served with cookies \& chips. Alex to get water. Bounce Houses will cost $\$ 400$ Total cost will be approximately $\$ 2700$.
