Four Course Sequence

- SVLD 501 – Servant Leadership Theory and Practice (3 credits)
- SVLD 550 – Building Community (3 credits)
- SVLD 546 – Special Topics: Teaching, Serving, Leading (3 credit course and conference)
- ETHL 531 – Interpersonal and Organizational Excellence I (3 credits) or
ETHL 532 – Interpersonal and Organizational Excellence II (3 credits)

Upon completion of the four courses listed above (12 credits) student will earn a graduate level certificate in Ethical Leadership. If a student decides to continue on to earn a graduate degree, all 12 credits can be transferred into our Master of Arts in Servant Leadership program. Up to six credits may be transferred into graduate programs in business and education.
