We are a SAGE school that offers the following programs: English Language Learners, High Performance Learners, Learning Disabilities, and Emotional & Behavioral Disabilities.

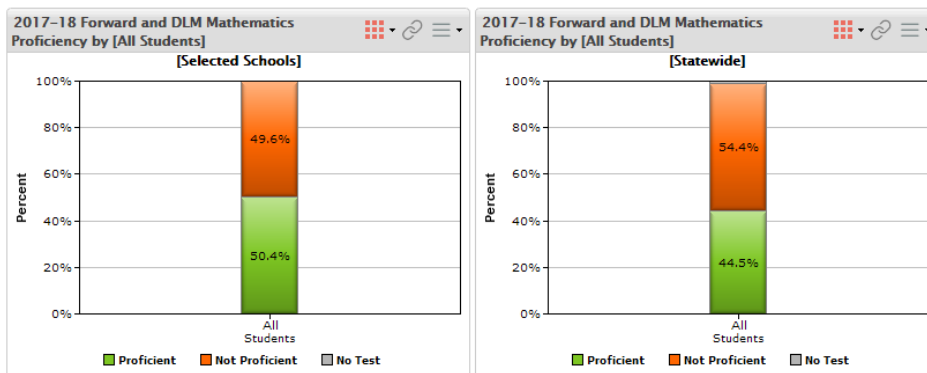
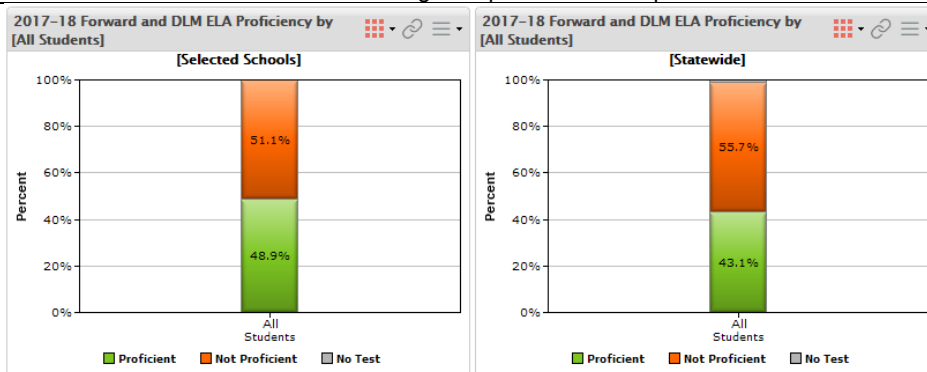
